

Arkabutla Lake

LOCATION: Arkabutla Lake is located on the Coldwater River 4 miles East of Coldwater, which is approximately 10 miles south of Hernando on Interstate 55.

SIZE: The conservation pool is approximately 5,100 acres, recreation pool is approximately 11,240 acres and flood control pool is approximately 33,400 acres.

DEPTH: Depth varies with reservoir stage.

AQUATIC VEGETATION: None.

MAJOR SPORTFISH: Crappie, catfish, bream, white bass, black bass and largemouth bass.

OTHER FISH: Bowfin, buffalo, common carp, drum, flathead catfish, green sunfish, gar

FISH FORAGE: Shad, minnows, sunfish.

VISIBLE COVER: Willow flats, buttonbush, cypress trees, rip-rap.

BOTTOM FEATURES: Dropoffs, man-made fish structures, sandbars, creek channels.

- 6 - Hernando Point Area
