

Townsend Lake

LOCATION: Approximately five miles southeast of Belzoni, MS.

SIZE: 70 acres.

DEPTH: Varies from 12 to 15 feet.

AQUATIC VEGETATION: Duckweed.

MAJOR SPORTFISH: Largemouth bass, crappie, bream (bluegill), channel catfish.

OTHER FISH: Bowfin, buffalo, common carp, drum, flathead catfish, green sunfish, gar.

FISH FORAGE: Shad, minnows, sunfish.

VISIBLE COVER: Cypress trees.

BOTTOM FEATURES: Underwater root systems, cypress knees, logs.





MAN-MADE FISH STRUCTURES: None
